

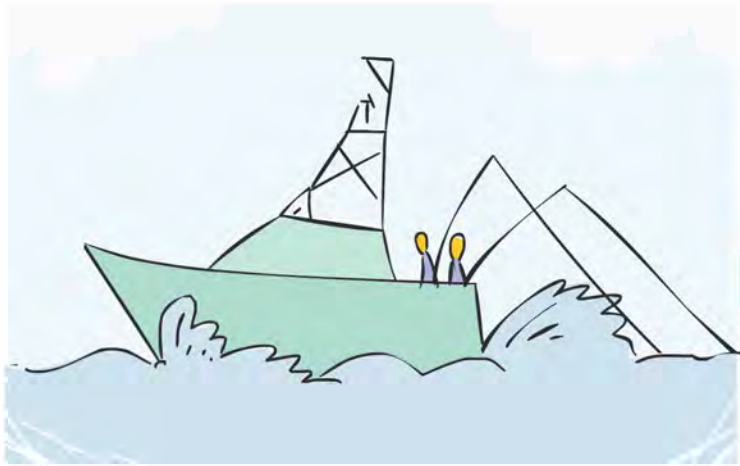

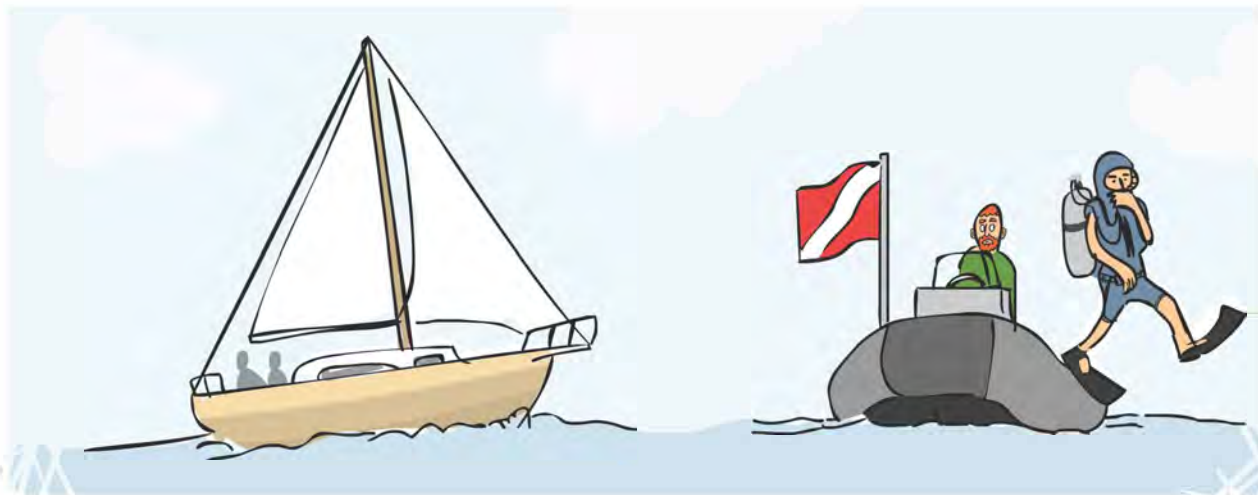

Sea Trials: Many boat brokers and dealers use licensed captains to conduct sea trials on behalf of potential buyers.

Networking and word of mouth is an effective way of finding the best jobs within the marine industry. Most jobs are never advertised and the ones that are you wouldn't want.



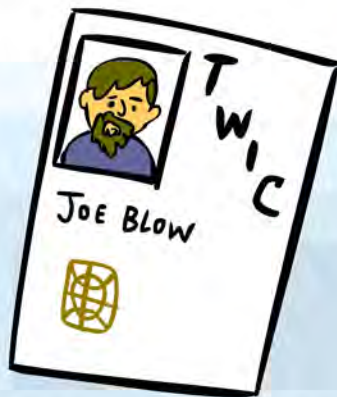
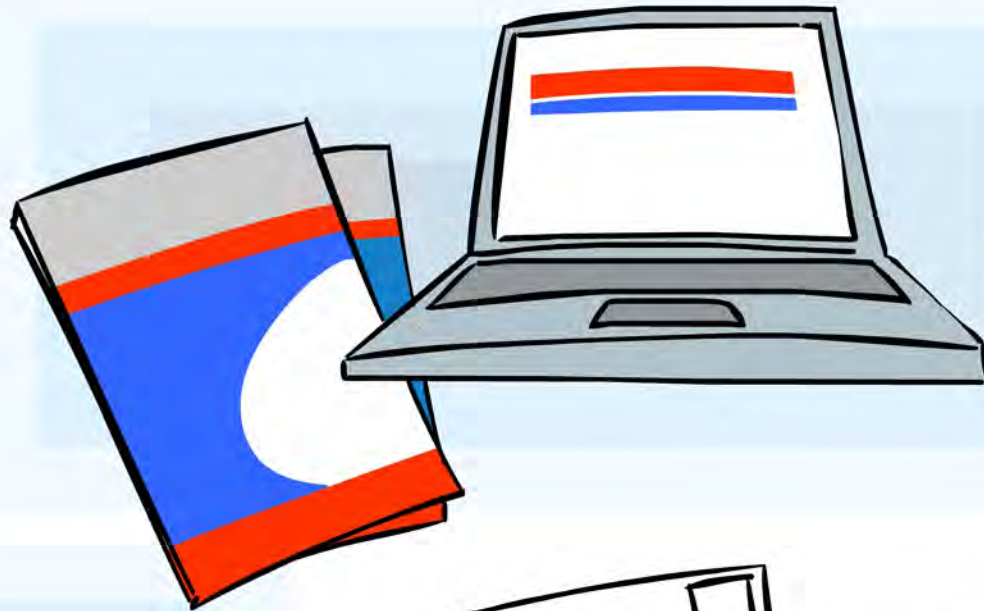
Boat brokers: are a great source for finding delivery and instructor work.

SO HOW DO I GET MY LICENSE?

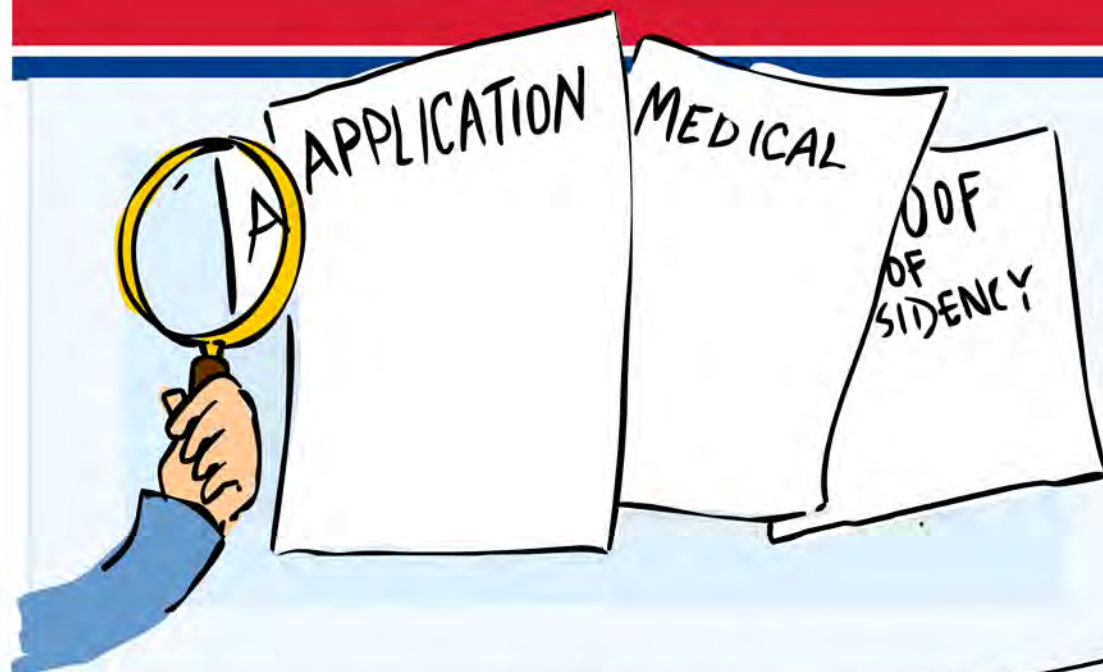
Take an Approved Course - Mariners Learning System has received the coveted approval from the USCG and offers a learning solution designed with today's student in mind.
